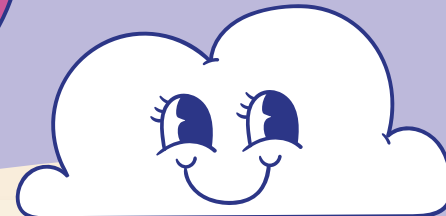

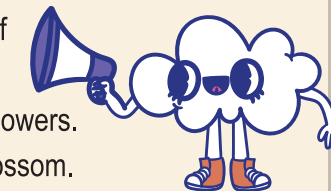
I think everybody will be considerate so we can make the library better and better.
